



Agility Trial Rules, General Information and Titling International Windsprite Club

A. IWC Agility Trial Rules and General Information:

- Canine Performance Events (CPE) rules will be in place. CPE Rulebook: <https://cpe.dog/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/2026-Agility-Rulebook.pdf>
- Agility competition is open to all Windsprites (longhair or smooth) registered with the International Windsprite Club. These dogs may be intact or altered.
- The following levels may be provided for Agility:
 - Level 1 (equivalent to CPE 1)
 - Level 2 (equivalent to CPE 2)
 - Level 3 (equivalent to CPE 3)
 - Level 5 (equivalent to CPE 5)
 - Level C (equivalent to CPE C)
- The following classes will be provided for Agility:
 - Standard Class Regular and Veterans
 - Games Class (Game may be Full House and/or Jumpers, or a game of the Judge's own design) Regular and Veterans
 - CPE rules will be utilized, except that there will be separate additional classes for:
 - Puppies: age 6 months to less than 12 months who will jump 4" to no higher than 12" and age 12 to less than 15 months who will jump 4" to no higher than 16" (handler's choice of jump height within these limits),
 - Veteran Dogs (Regular) (age 9 to <12 years), will jump one jump height lower than the P-Card,
 - Senior Veteran Dogs: (12 + Years old) will jump two jump heights lower than the P-card for Senior Veteran dogs and will have 5 seconds extra to complete the course.
- IWC Agility Levels:
 - Dogs may start at Level 1, 2, or 3.
 - Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, Level 5, and Level C titles will be offered, regardless of titles that dogs may have in other organizations. FEO runs will not get a placement or be eligible for Triathlon or Versatility awards.

B. IWC Titling Requirements:

- Standard Level 1, Two qualifying legs required for a title = AS1/ ASV1
- Standard Level 2, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AS2/ASV2
- Standard Level 3, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AS3/ASV3
- Standard Level 5, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AS5/ASV5
- Standard Level C, Three qualifying legs required for a title = ASC/ASCV
- Games Level 1, Two qualifying legs required for a title = AG1/AGV1
- Games Level 2, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AG2/AGV2
- Games Level 3, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AG3/AGV3
- Games Level 5, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AG5/AGV5
- Games Level C, Three qualifying legs required for a title = AGC/AGV

C. Definition of Championship Titles:

- Agility Champion - Three qualifying legs in Standard Level 5 plus three qualifying legs in Games Level 5 earns the title of Agility Champion = AgCH/AgCHV
- Agility Grand Champion – Three qualifying legs in Standard Level C and three qualifying legs in Games Level C earns the title of Agility Grand Champion = AgGCH/AgGCHV

Note: Once a title is completed, advancement to the next level is not required. You may continue to earn qualifying legs. When six legs are earned, the number 2 is added to the title (e.g., AS1-2). When 9 legs are earned, the number 3 is added to the title (e.g., AS1-3), and so on.
